Montague ISD considers the safety of our students as our utmost priority. The Administration and Board of Trustees are committed to providing a safe campus. A summary of the strategies we have implemented are listed below.

- Montague ISD requires staff development for employees using the Safe Schools Program.
- Montague ISD has a door entrance system that requires visitors to ring at the entrance before being allowed to enter.
- Montague ISD has a security system monitored by 24/7.
- Montague ISD has security cameras installed and actively recording 24/7
- Montague ISD has installed emergency alert buttons at undisclosed locations on campus that will notify the sheriff, fire department and all area first responders when activated.
- Montague ISD has specific district employees authorized by the Board of Trustees, pursuant to its authority under Texas Penal Code 46.03(a)(1) and CKC board policy, to possess a concealed handgun at school and at school-sponsored or school-related events to the extent allowed by state law and rules known as the Guardian Plan.
- Montague ISD Administration utilizes the Montague County Emergency Alert Notification System.

Our number one goal at Montague ISD is to make the learning atmosphere as safe as possible for our students and staff.
