Montague ISD Dress and Grooming Code [FACE COVERINGS]

Effective 8/26/2020

Montague ISD will comply with the Montague County Health Order in compliance with Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-29 that states the following requirement: "Wear a face covering over the nose and mouth when inside a commercial building or other building or space open to the public or when in an outdoor space, wherever it is not feasible to maintain 6' of social distancing from another person not in the same household.

The following face covering **exceptions** pertaining to Montague ISD are as follows:

- Exceptions apply for the 3rd grade and below
- Any person consuming food or drink or seated in the cafeteria.
- Any person with a medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering.
- Any University Interscholastic League (UIL) rules regarding face coverings during UIL sponsored activities.
- Any person exercising outdoors or engaging in physical activity while maintaining a safe distance of 6'.

All students in the **4th grade and above** must wear a protective mask or full-face shield at all times while on school property for so long as, based on recommendations from local and state health authorities, district officials deem it necessary during the 2020-2021 school year.

Students receiving on-campus instruction who do not comply with the COVID-19 protective face covering requirement may be required to remain off-campus and receive remote instruction until the student becomes compliant with the requirement.

Montague ISD will provide each student with a reusable mask. Students are welcome to wear a mask or face shield of their choosing as long as it complies with the dress code guidelines.
