


This visual guide will assist in setting up and using Istation Home, which will allow to access the Istation curriculum outside school. The student will need to have taken the initial ISIP™ assessment on their school campus in order to have a personalized instructional path. The student will also need to know the username and password they use to login at school.

#### Step 1:

Go to the Web site [www.istation.com](http://www.istation.com) and click on **Download & Technical Info.**



#### Step 2:

Click the appropriate button to download Istation for Windows or Macintosh, iPad, Android, and Chromebook. Applications can be downloaded on the device from the corresponding app store.


Istation operates on any device:



#### Step 3:


Click on the desktop app. The first time you log in, you will be prompted to type the child's school name in the domain field. Domain name format is school.district.state (e.g., mcnair.dallas.tx). No information is needed in the Peer Group field.

*Choose the middle one -

#### Step 4:

- Enter your user name and password provided by the classroom teacher. Do not use Caps key; it defaults to uppercase letters.
- Click the OK button.



#### Step 5:

Select one of the following:

- Reading with ISIP or Lectura con ISIP\* – personalized reading instructional path
- Books or Libros\* –students may reread any interactive books they have experienced in the program
- Writing Rules! with Calvin Cool (recommended for 3rd – 8th grade)
- Math with ISIP\* – personalized math instructional path
- lpractice or lpractice en Español\* – student-selected activities from the Istation curriculum
- Assignments – extra practice activities assigned by the teacher
