Montague ISD Athletic Policy 2020-21

- 1 All female athletes are expected to abide by the Lady Eagle Contract. If there is a violation of the Contract, the following will occur:
 - 1st time- warned- read contract
 - 2nd time- parent conference
 - 3rd time-possible removal from sport
- 2 All athletes are expected to dress out if they are present in class regardless of sickness or injury unless the injury or sickness is accompanied by a doctor's note.
- 3 Each athlete will be issued game clothing on the day of the game. The school washes game uniforms after every game. Personal items such as socks and knee pads, etc. should be washed at home. If anything is lost or ruined, the athlete is responsible for paying for the item. Replacement costs for uniforms and practice attire vary from time to time as they are replaced. PE students may be issued practice clothes if they did not buy form the online store.
- 4 The following points are deducted from 6 weeks grades:
 - If an athlete forgets practice clothes or shoes- 3 points NOTE: if an athlete forgets shoes or clothes for practice, they will still work out in their street clothes and no shoes.
- 5 Missed workouts due to absences must be made up unless there is an injury. This rule applies to all workouts including before, during and after school.
 NOTE: The only exception to this rule is if an athlete is absent due to a school function (UIL, field trips, etc.) or a family funeral (with parent note or text).
- 6 No jewelry is allowed during games or practices. Repeated infractions will result in daily points deducted from athlete's grades.
- 7 Being late to practice or a game is unacceptable and the athlete will have to stay after practice for make up.
- 8 Montague athletics is a 7th and 8th grade athletic program. 6th graders may participate in sports if the numbers are low in the 7th and 8th grade. Only 1 team may be formed if 6th graders participate.
- 9 All athletes are expected to be picked up from practice or games on time, please make arrangements prior to the game or practice.
- 10 All athletes must receive a medical physical prior to any practice in athletics. MISD requires a medical physical to be completed in the 6th grade and then again in the 7th grade. All UIL forms must be turned in before participation.
- 11 If an athlete or parent has any problems, please contact the coach to set up a conference.

I agree that I am responsible for any athletic items that are checked out to me or my child and if they are ruined or lost I am responsible for paying for the replacement cost.
